Pavia-Würzburg Summer School on Language and Law
18-23 September 2023
University of Pavia, Italy

The School is organized by the Department of Law, University of Pavia.

Scope and Objective

The course will focus on English legal language applied to the study of European Union law and is designed to enable students and professionals who already possess a basic knowledge of English to improve their knowledge of legal English, which is necessary to enter an increasingly internationalized professional world. The teaching activity will be carried out by University lecturers of legal English and of European Union Law, and high-ranking officials from the European Union. The co-existence of native English-speaking lecturers, law lecturers and officials is aimed at providing a training that is both legal and linguistic, theoretical and practical. Teaching will therefore be articulated both in face-to-face classes and in practical exercises and writing workshops.

The school will address the following topics:

- ✓ Legal English;
- ✓ Legal Writing;
- ✓ Legal translation in the European Union;
- ✓ European Human Rights and Fundamental Freedoms;
- ✓ Current issues of EU Law;
- ✓ US Legal terminology in the Supreme Court case law
- ✓ Database research.

The target of the school

The school is taught in English. It includes (i) classroom lectures, which aim to provide participants with a conceptual framework of legal English and EU law; (ii) workshops and simulations.

Can I apply?

The course is designed for students and PhD students enrolled in the Departments of Law, Humanities, Political Science, Economics, and professionals at an early stage of their career.
