REQUIREMENTS (for international students, Erasmus and other international exchange programmes)

- Being in Pavia for the period between October and March. Being in Pavia for an entire academic year would be preferable. Students in Pavia for one semester only may exceptionally be considered.
- Good knowledge of the English language, both written and spoken. The competition will in fact be entirely in English.

HOW TO PARTICIPATE IN THE SELECTION

Please send your CV and any language certifications to: candidature.vismootpavia@gmail.com by **9th October 2025**. The selection of team members is based on the merit and motivation of the candidates, who will be assessed through a short interview to be held at a date and time to be announced.

ROADMAP OF THE COMPETITION

- **October 2025:** Publication of the case, involving a dispute concerning an international contract for the sale of goods and services governed by the Convention on Contracts for the International Sale of Goods (CISG).
- **December 2025:** Conclusion and upload of the Memorandum for the Claimant - **January 2026:** Conclusion and upload of Memorandum for the Respondent - **February-March 2026:** Start of simulations and oral phase, with virtual and in-person PreMoots - **April 2026:** General rounds in Vienna

The team will be coached and followed throughout the competition by Avv. Mario de Nitto Personè and by Studio Legale LCA of Milan.

Reimbursement will be provided for travel expenses incurred for the Pre-Moots and General Rounds,

as well as the attribution of up to 12 curricular CFUs for participants in the Competition.
